- e) **ACBS TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR / SECRETARY GENERAL** : For the duration of the tournament plus two extra days.

Any other free accommodation will be at the discretion of the Host Association

DAILY ALLOWANCES

The Host Association is required to provide daily allowance to the overseas referees as below :

US\$10 (ten) per day for the duration of the tournament plus two extra days.
